

SHARED INSIGHTS ACROSS SIX CONCURRENT CONFERENCE STREAMS

Throughout the three-day conference, IMARC 2025 welcomed more than 500 speakers who delivered over 380 technical talks, panel discussions, interviews and keynote presentations across six concurrent conferences spanning the entire mining value chain. Notably, more than 150 of these speakers were women, reflecting IMARC's ongoing commitment to its Balance for Better initiative, which promotes equality, diversity, and inclusion throughout the mining sector.

The packed plenary sessions explored three central themes:

Finding, Funding and Fast-Tracking Mining Projects

Driving Decarbonisation and Productivity through Collaboration, Technology, and Innovation

Mobilising the Mining Ecosystem for Shared Prosperity

New to the program, the Mining Operators Series was designed for professionals working at the frontline of operations, featuring sessions on modernising machinery, boosting productivity and optimising mining processes.

The IMARC Exchange Roundtables provided an opportunity for meaningful small-group discussions where ideas were exchanged, partnerships formed, and real solutions developed. These included the Talk It Forward Dialogue Program, which encouraged open dialogue and new perspectives on advancing ESG initiatives, and the Innovation & Investment Alley Program, which showcased emerging technology innovators presenting their cutting-edge solutions to venture capitalists and mining innovation leaders.

The broader conference program also featured sessions on Digital Transformation, Mining Innovation, Mining Investment and Energy Transition & Decarbonisation. Attendees also benefited from over 10 free-to-attend country/region presentation series in the Global Opportunities Theatre, highlighting trade and investment opportunities from around Australia, Latin America, Canada, Europe, Africa, Asia and more.



The event commenced with an International Government Meet and Greet, sponsored by Wood Mackenzie, held the day before the official opening. This invitation-only networking session provided a relaxed environment for Ministers, Ambassadors, High Commissioners, Consul-Generals, senior Government officials, and dignitaries to connect and exchange insights ahead of the main conference.

51 COUNTRIES REPRESENTED AT A GOVERNMENT AND/OR MINISTERIAL LEVEL

IMARC 2025 once again reinforced its position as Australia's leading international mining and resources event, where the world's industry leaders come together to explore opportunities, address challenges, forge strategic alliances and advance the future for the global mining industry.

The 2025 conference was officially opened by NSW Premier Hon. Chris Minns, alongside NSW Finance Minister and Minister for Natural Resources Hon. Courtney Housos, and Australia's Assistant Minister for Resources Senator Anthony Chisholm. For the first time, IMARC featured several ministerial-level representatives from Australian states, including South Australian Minister for Trade and Investment Joe Szakacs MP, Minister for Energy and Resources Victoria, Hon. Lily D'Ambrosio, Queensland Natural Resources and Mines Minister Hon. Dale Last and Queensland Shadow Resources Minister Senator Susan McDonald, highlighting the event's national significance.

Ministers and government officials from five continents joined their Australian counterparts in IMARC 2025's conference program, including representatives from Uganda, France, Pakistan, Chile, and several other nations, bringing together significant global political influence and perspective. Among the international highlights, H.E. Khalid Al Mudaifer, Vice-Minister for Mining Affairs, Ministry of Industry and Mineral Resources of Saudi Arabia, delivered a keynote presentation on the Kingdom's Vision 2030, underscoring its ambitious transformation agenda. IMARC also welcomed New Zealand's Minister for Resources, Hon. Shane Jones, who showcased New Zealand's resource potential to investors and global partners, while Utah Governor Spencer Cox highlighted the state's mining capabilities and referenced the landmark Australia-United States critical minerals agreement signed earlier that week.

On the exhibition floor, all Australian state and territories were represented with dedicated stands, alongside international pavilions from Peru, Sweden, Germany, Italy, Saudi Arabia, New Zealand, Morocco, Mongolia, India, Timor-Leste, and Canada (Quebec and Ontario), facilitating trade and investment opportunities across borders.

In total, 180 global Ministers, Ambassadors, High Commissioners, Consul-Generals, and senior officials participated at IMARC 2025, which attracted around 11,000 registered attendees and decision-makers with 26% coming from overseas. Numerous bilateral meetings took place throughout the event, fostering new partnerships and investment discussions across the international mining landscape.

NEW AND RETURNING HIGHLIGHTS FROM AROUND THE SHOW

INNOVATION AND INVESTMENT ALLEY

The new Innovation & Investment Alley on the expo floor was a vibrant showcase of pioneering technologies transforming the mining industry. From intelligent automation and clean energy systems to next-generation process optimisation tools, it connected startups, researchers, and technology developers with investors, miners, and venture capitalists ready to accelerate innovation into commercial reality. The Alley gave future-defining ideas their first major platform to build momentum for solutions that can reshape the industry economically, socially, and sustainably. Participating innovators and commercialisation partners included EcoHoist, Health & Wellness Water, RapidGraphite, Banksia Minerals Processing, OreSand, Rainstick, TreeTrack, DNAir, Endolith, Quenda, Ekion, AI Risk & Safety, Mugathu, Critical Minerals, and Bioculum.

PITCH BATTLES

The IMARC Pitch Battles continued to celebrate innovation and collaboration in mining. In the METS Innovation Pitch Battle, five companies from the Innovation & Investment Alley presented their technologies to a panel of investors and mining leaders, with Liz Dennett, Founder and CEO of Endolith, taking top honours. The Mining Pitch Battle Grand Final saw three junior mining executives pitch their projects in a highly engaging final round, with Marcy Kiesman, CEO of Quantum Critical Metals, crowned the winner.

VIP HOSTED BUYER PROGRAM

The VIP Hosted Buyer Program returned this year, attracting more participating executives from mining companies and contractors responsible for strategic procurement of mining equipment, technology, and services. The program featured a curated exhibition tour, showcasing cutting-edge innovations, along with personalised meetings and access to exclusive networking functions. Notable participants included buyers from Rio Tinto, PLS, South32, Perenti, Boggabri Coal, Glencore, Byrncut, and Newmont.

Building on its previous success, OnAir @ IMARC returned in 2025 with video interviews and podcasts from leading media outlets including ABC Radio, Money of Mine, Mining.com.au, Sweat Capital, Digging Deeper with @ The Coalface, Mine Australia, Making Money Matter, and Graphite Hub. Over three days, this dedicated zone on the exhibition floor delivered high-impact coverage, daily mining news, exhibitor announcements, and thought-provoking discussions with industry leaders, reaching a combined global audience in the millions.



GALA DINNER AWARDS

This year's Gala Dinner expanded to include two exciting new awards recognising the industry's future leaders and innovators. Alongside the prestigious Mines and Money Legend in Mining Award, presented to Owen Hegarty OAM for his 50-year contribution to the global mining industry, IMARC introduced the NextGen Leaders Award (sponsored by Coal Australia) and the Mining Beacon Breakthrough Innovation Award (sponsored by RFC Ambrian). Renzo Ocampo, a junior geologist at Barton Gold, won the IMARC NextGen Leaders Award for his insights on DEI, community engagement, and sustainability, while MOVUS received the Mining Beacon Breakthrough Innovation Award for its Ultra vSense sensor technology.

IMARC's NextGen Program continues to inspire our future workforce, facilitate career pathways, and promote talent retention within the mining and resources sector. 




STOCK EXCHANGE








FIRST NATIONS PARTNERS
