

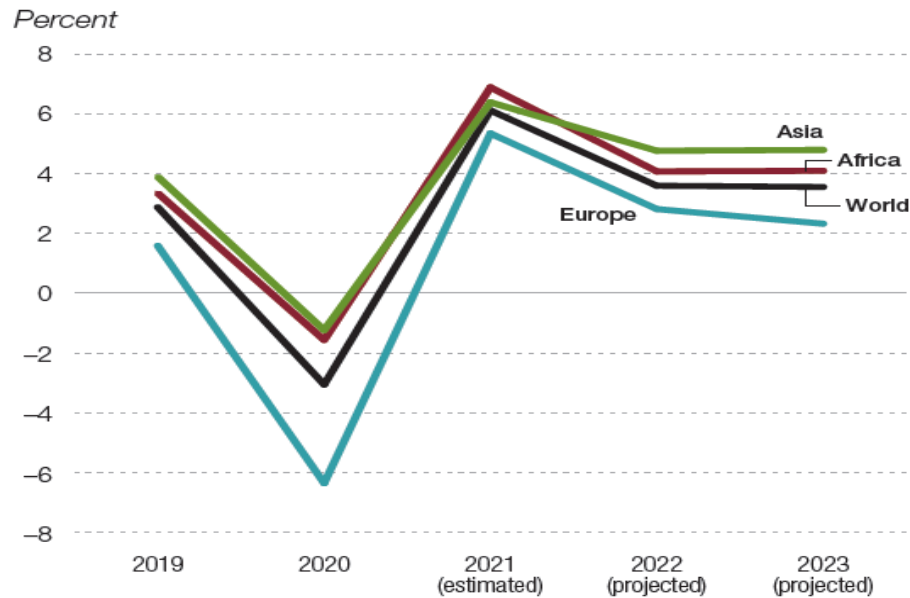

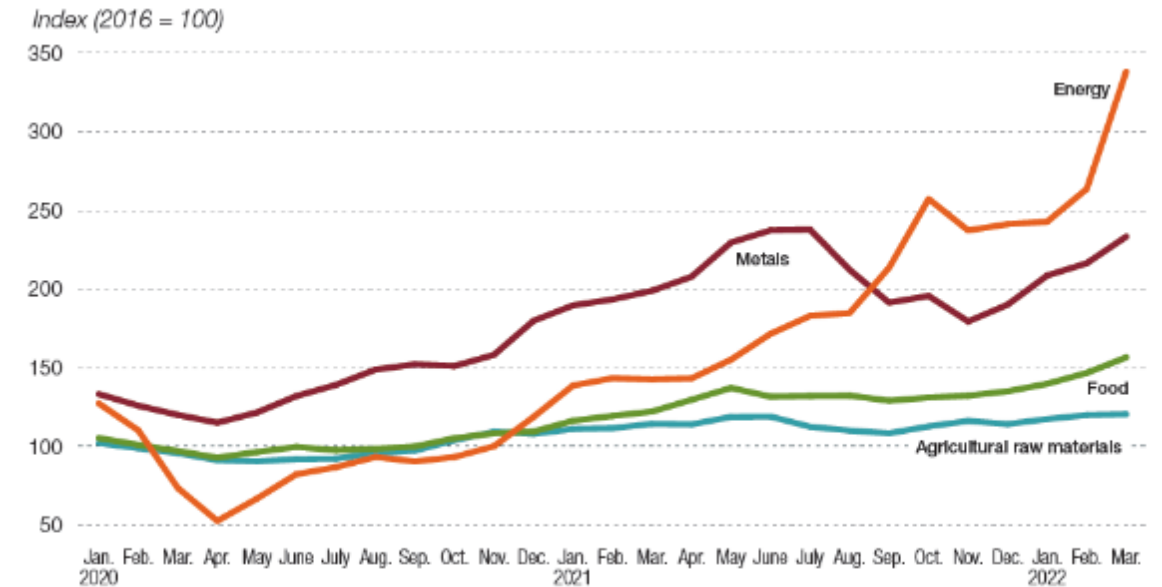

FIGURE 2 Global commodity price indices, January 2020–March 2022

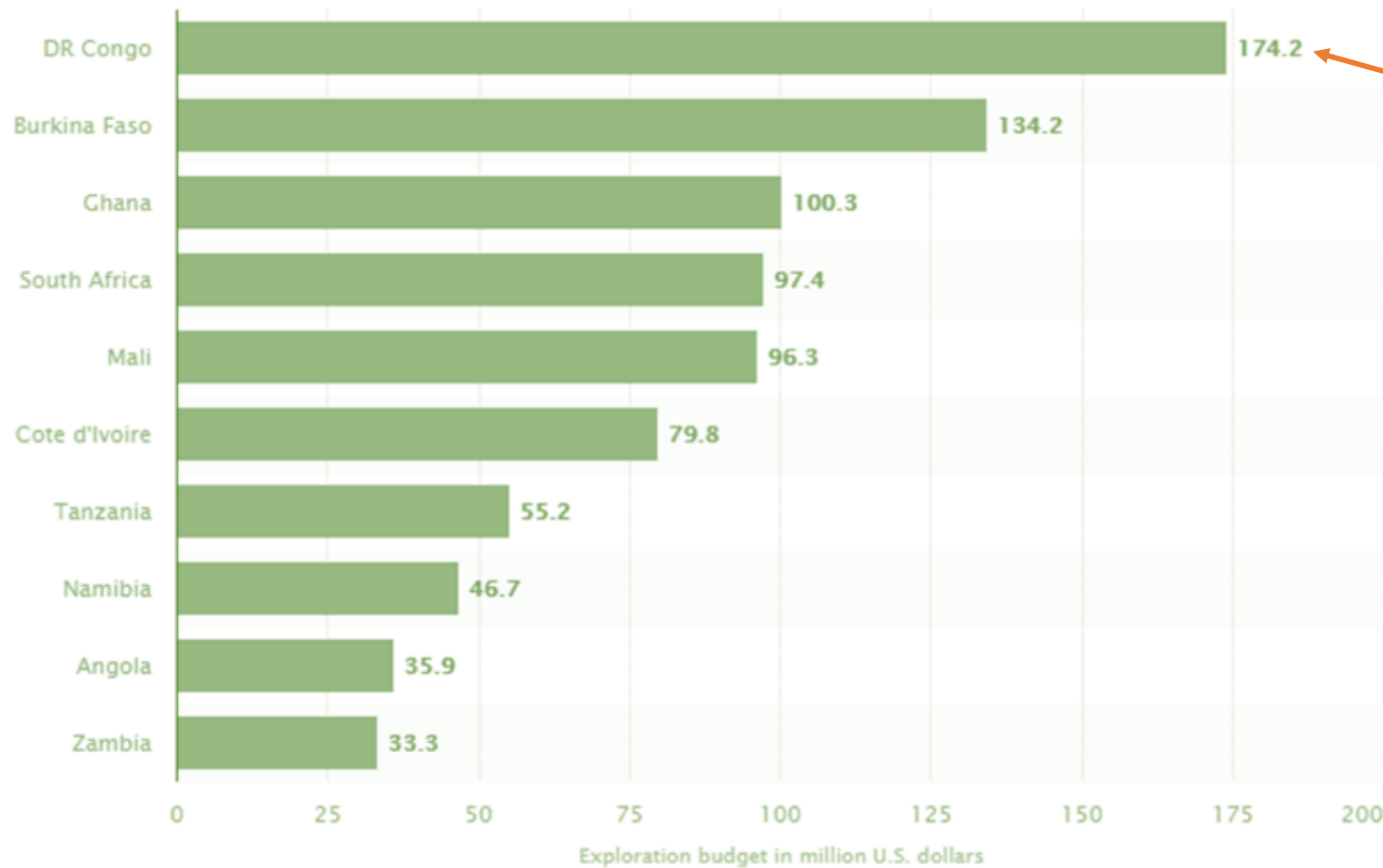

- Growth is projected to accelerate to **4%** in 2022—driven by **mining** and the recovery of agriculture, manufacturing, construction, and tourism—and then marginally improve to 4.2% in 2023.

DRC ranked 9th in the world as a country with the most natural resources

- Africa's mining industry is of global significance.
- The mining exploration budget in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DR Congo) was over **174** billion U.S. dollars in 2019, making it the country with the largest mining exploration budget in all of Africa that year.
