Overview

Scenario

Climate change and extreme natural phenomena are affecting the balance of life on the planet every day.

We need to speed up the transition to the circular economy to meet the goals of the Green Deal but also to ensure greater strategic autonomy for Europe and Italy in the supply of raw materials.

2024 will be important for the roll-out of investments and reforms envisaged in the Next Generation EU.

At European level, the new Circular Economy Action Plan and the new Industrial Programme for the Green Deal will continue to be implemented.

Italy is among the leading countries in Europe, but it is still proceeding too slowly: it needs effective and consistent public policies to support the ecological transition (while ensuring their industrial and fiscal policies are appropriate), to overcome the barriers that impede the circular economy, and to fully exploit its potential.

Mission

Ecomondo is the meeting place where industrial groups, stakeholders, policy makers, opinion leaders, local authorities, research bodies and institutions come together and put in place the key elements that define the strategies for the development of EU environmental policy.

It is the key international event in Europe and the Mediterranean basin for technologies, services and industrial solutions in the green and circular economy sectors.

A hub for research and innovation, Ecomondo offers information, sharing and co-design on **European Green Deal** policies through the creation of public-private partnerships involved in national, European and international planning.

Over the four days of the event and throughout the year, Ecomondo addresses issues related to the progress of Next Generation EU flagship projects and the level of adoption in Italy, Europe and internationally of the circular economy in the main industrial value chains, as well as the restoration and ecological regeneration of soils and the hydrosphere, coastlines and circular and healthy cities.

It also provides information and networking opportunities on funding for research and innovation as well as new policies, and offers insights into the **new languages of communication** to facilitate the transition to sustainable processes and high-quality training opportunities at all levels, for those working in public administration, self-employed people, and sustainability managers and professionals.






Blue Economy

At the heart of the eastern area of the fairgrounds, this district showcases water resources and the sea by engaging visitors and exhibitors in an exhibition and content route.

The Blue Economy district aims to spread best practices and projects related to the economy of the seas, oceans and coasts by addressing the European Union's mission to restore the ecosystems of its oceans and waters by 2030. It hosts technologies for hydrosphere depollution and regeneration, the desalination of water and the regeneration of ports, coasts and coastal activities.

TEXXTI J

Textile District

Separate waste collection, reuse, recycling, eco-design, fashion renting and second-hand: with the Textile District, Ecomondo can put itself forward as the capital of ethical fashion thanks to an exhibition space involving all the players in the supply chain and a packed programme of events aimed at focusing attention on a more sustainable model for the sector.

A project of huge importance considering that the textile industry has been identified as a key value chain, for which the European Union has planned measures to improve its sustainability, circularity, traceability and transparency.



Paper District

Launched in 2023 — with the cooperation of Comieco, Unirima and the Paper and Graphics Federation — and expanded in 2024, the Paper District is the exhibition and content space designed for the entire paper and cardboard industry.

This successful experiment has brought together paper mills, certifiers, the transformation industry, PA, municipalities, the sorting industry, but also treatment, valorisation and trading services, and given visitors a snapshot of one of the most virtuous supply chains in Italy.

The project also has a workshop area dedicated to companies for conferences, meetings and company case studies.

Ecomondo is strengthening its role as an incubator for innovative projects. It explores cutting-edge topics, including Millennials and Gen Z, to shape today's technological research and create tomorrow's answers and jobs.

START-UP & SCALE-UPS

Internationalisation

Through an integrated internationalisation strategy, Ecomondo is increasingly consolidating its position as a reference point for Europe and the Mediterranean basin, and boosting its reputation overseas. It fosters the presence of international exhibitors and visitors through:

- omnichannel communication on and offline;
- missions and participation at trade shows and conferences on the ecological transition abroad;
- network of partnerships around the world to promote the show and the **Hosted Buyer programme**;
- dialogue with and involvement of numerous institutional representatives and international sector associations.

With this strategy, the number of countries with potential strong demand for innovative technologies and solutions for the ecological transition will be further increased.

INTERNATIONAL BUYER PROGRAMME

Thanks to the programme to retain and expand international delegates, in synergy with the Italian Trade Agency and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI), at its last few editions, Ecomondo has met the challenging objective of fostering dialogue and business relations by involving more than 620 international buyers (2023 figure).

Conventions programme

Ecomondo 2024 will host the extensive and high-quality programme of conferences, seminars and events aimed at exploring the main technological, regulatory and market innovations in the circular economy sectors of organic and non-organic value chains, water resource management and environmental monitoring & control, the regenerative economy and environmental risk prevention.

To ensure the quality, innovative and international nature of the contents, the Technical Scientific Committee consists of a pool of 80 members that includes scientists, technicians, managers and representatives of national institutions, sector associations and federations, consortia, agencies and institutes.

The international programme will mainly focus on Europe and the Mediterranean, and will be facilitated by the European Commission, the OECD, the FAO, the EEA, ISWA International, Water Europe, UfM and KICs.

States General of the Green Economy is a strategic, open and participatory process involving the main stakeholders of the Italian green economy.

It is the key annual event for the Italian green economy, promoted by the National Council for the Green Economy, in partnership with the Ministry for the Environment and Energy Security and under the patronage of the European Commission. It proposes policies and measures for the transition to the green economy in Italy, and provides an analysis and update of trends in strategic green economy sectors.



SAFTE is the Advanced Training School for Ecological Transition promoted by Ecomondo-Italian Exhibition Group and directed by Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna, in collaboration with ReteAmbiente.
