

# **Industry Priorities**








## Exhibition Overview - The Global Energy Industry Exhibits at Gastech






Satisfaction levels of the top 3 objectives exhibitors had when exhibiting at Gastech





# **Conference Overview**

The Gastech Conference took place in Houston, between 17-19 September 2019. The sheer size of the conference (over 2,500 attendees) is a testament to how significant natural gas has become in the global energy equation and how important Gastech is as a meeting place to air these discussions and to conduct business.

Key recurring themes from this year's conference focused on the buoyancy of the global gas market, the continued growth in demand across Asia, and in the relevance of natural gas and LNG as positive energy solutions that help countries achieve climate change commitments.

Strong Global Demand: "Gas is the fuel of the future," said H.E. Nadeem Babar, Special Assistant to the Prime Minister (SAPM) on Petroleum Division, Islamic Republic of Pakistan. Babar is right, but natural gas is also the fuel of today. The International Energy Agency (IEA) observed that natural gas accounted for 45% of the rise in global energy consumption last year, on its way to emerging as what the IEA deemed the "fuel of choice."

Market Dominated by Asia, Especially India and China: Gastech was an opportunity to see just how hungry India is for affordable and reliable energy. India currently plans to build 11 new LNG import terminals over just the next 7 years. According to the International Energy Agency, the Asia Pacific region is forecast to account for approximately 60% of total natural gas consumption growth between now and 2024. Natural Gas is a Climate Solution: H.E. Ashish Chatterjee, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas, Republic of India, told the Gastech attendees that his country is "focusing on promoting natural gas" due to "concerns of carbon emissions." Address Methane: While Gastech discussions were nearly unanimous in identifying the climate benefits of natural gas, there is still more work to be done. Industry leaders throughout the multi-day program stressed that reducing methane emissions must be a priority.

#### An Opportunity for the U.S.:

Over the next few years, the United States will become the world's third largest exporter of LNG, behind only Qatar and Australia. Last month, the United States had already captured 10% of the global LNG market. Since at least 2012, the United States has been the world's largest natural gas producer and recently became a net natural gas exporter.



**Charif Souki**, Chairman of Tellurian told CNN's Fareed Zakaria of the urgent need to invest \$300bn into US infrastructure to help push shale gas to markets.

"The necessity to do it is absolutely there. If not, you either flare it or you do not produce the oil that comes with it."



**Francis Fannon**, Assistant Secretary for Fossil Energy at the US State Department discussed the increasing profile of energy in leveraging international diplomacy:

"We work with foreign countries to understand their energy ambition, which direction is the energy demand going if they want gas as a foundation. It's not a switch that can be flipped. 




