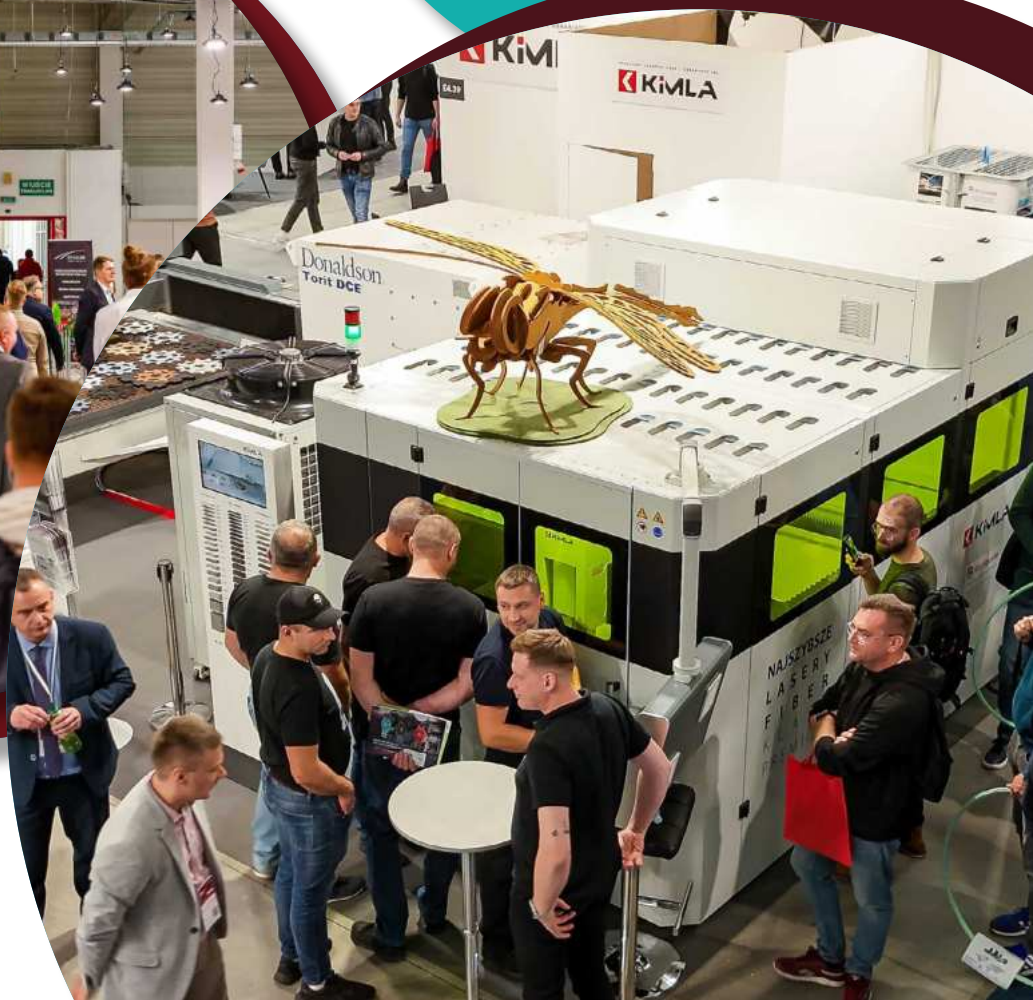

WARSAW INDUSTRY WEEK 2025

The **Warsaw Industry Week 2025** Trade Fair has once again confirmed its position as one of the largest and most important industrial events in Central and Eastern Europe. This year's edition brought together 524 exhibitors who presented modern production technologies, automation and robotics solutions, industrial machines, processing systems, as well as innovations supporting the development of manufacturing facilities. The event was visited by 22,573 specialists and industry representatives, demonstrating the strong interest from manufacturing companies, system integrators, engineers, and management personnel. 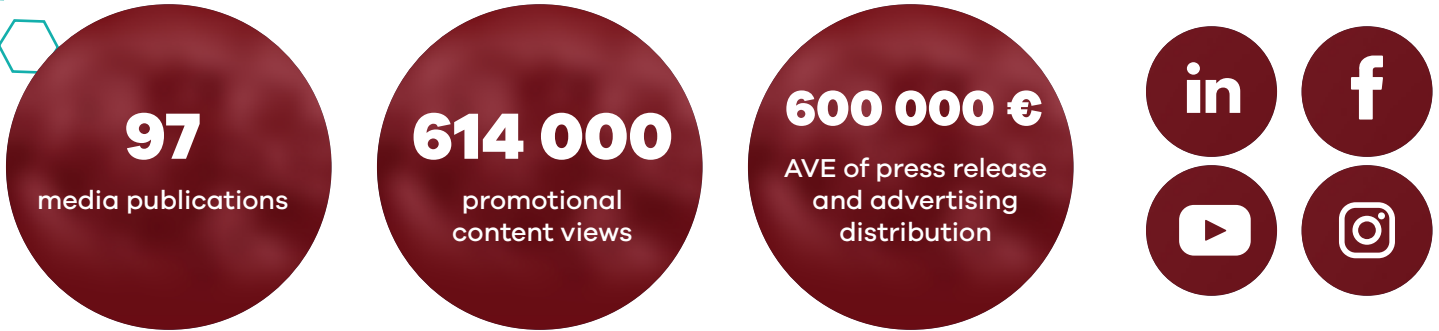
